Goal #1 - Off net front scramble, puck gets to point where seeing eye shot finds way through blocker side. Possible tip in mid slot. Goal #2 poor d zone coverage, half wall net crash 2 on 1, easy tap in. Played play smart but aggressive, never had a chance. Goal #3 PP point shot right off faceoff, beat from distance. Limited screen. Goal #4 puck dribbles from board battle behind net through crease, mishandle covering it and Danbury player swoops in for rebound. Too upright on post looking over shoulder.

Arseni has been rock solid this season for the Storm as he has adjusted extremely well to USHL play coming from Shreveport in the NAHL. He has been consistent game to game and shift to shift which has been something Sergeyev has improved on over the last two seasons. It will be important to track how Sergeyev performs after he has a subpar performance.

Brendan Williamson - '02 Goaltender - Rockets Hockey Club (USPHL NCDC)

11/06/2021 - Rockets Hockey Club vs Utica Jr Comets

Light work through first half of game. Hard, quick skater with explosive slides. Multiple impressive saves handling one timers and high danger shot saves. 25 shots 23 saves

12/03/2021 - Rockets Hockey Club vs Philadelphia Hockey Club

Tough night, 3 goals on 9 shots in first period, yanked after goal #3. 2 point shots find ways through maze / body.

Carson Limesand - '02 Goaltender - Northeast Generals (NAHL)

09/18/2021 - NAHL Blaine Showcase

Extremely quick, athletic keeper who is very reliable and had an impressive showing this weekend. His speed allows him to square up to most shots and to recover rapidly to be in a strong position to stop rebounds. He has a fast glove hand and blocker. He uses his stick to deflect pucks into the corners and out of the Grade A areas.

Connor Bradford - '02 Goaltender - Boston Advantage (USPHL NCDC)

12/11/2021 - Northern Cyclones vs Boston Advantage

35 shots 32 saves. First save reactionary goaltender, not a traditional butterfly goaltender. Beat on powerplay one timer from half wall, late getting over, as well as a powerplay rebound goal and was not ready for goal #3 beat five hole from half wall . Was scambly with not much stick control in rebounds / recovery situations.

Connor Crawford - '02 Goaltender - Florida Jr Blades (USPHL Premier)

09/27/2021 - USPHL Premier Raleigh Southeast Showcase

Connor uses his size to his advantage all over the ice for the Everblades as he plays more of a power forward style of hockey. He's able to parlay that into some scoring chances with his ability to get to the net and create from time to time. Building off the good showcase weekend, look to expect more development throughout the year from the bigger sized forward.

David Battisti - '01 Goaltender - Charlotte Rush (USPHL Premier)

11/21/2021 - Charlotte Rush vs Pueblo Rush

19 shots 18 saves , beaten with traffic from inside dots . Aggressive positioning goaltender with strong instincts and reads, trys to play butterfly but unorthodox at times, especially in scrambles / secondary opportunities. Relies on reads and quick hands to attack pucks.

12/17/2021 - Charlotte Rush vs Tampa Bay Juniors

28 Shots 26 saves. Calm on first shots with an aggressive crease positioning. Did well handling point shots to the chest eliminating rebound chances, especially through traffic. Beat on tipped point shot, and garbage time scramble for rebound. Showed strong reads on pk and rush situations, not the most controlled movements laterally but made the saves needed.

Harrison Chesney - '01 Goaltender - PAL Jr Islanders (USPHL NCDC)

12/17/2021 - Philadelphia HC vs PAL Jr Islanders

#31 1 GA beat from outside circles on wall blocker side, poor goal. Wide stance, average movement speed. Hands close to body for large central coverage and active head tracking pucks and rebounds. Multiple in tight saves, allowed pucks to hit body keeping hands close instead of reacting to shot.

Ian Young - '01 Goaltender - Chicago Cougars (USPHL Premier)

10/24/2021 - USPHL Premier Detroit Showcase

Young has been a backbone for the Cougars early in the year and he was more of that over the weekend in Detroit. Young is a very balanced and technically sound goaltender. He gets his hands over pucks well and projects towards almost every puck. Lots of simple movements throughout that help make his job easy time and time again.

Jackson Bernard - '01 Goaltender - New York Applecore (EHL)

10/23/2021 - EHL All Star College Series

He is a positionally sound goaltender who moves rapidly in his crease from post-to-post. He uses his stick well to deflect pucks into corners and away from the high danger areas. He does a good job to smother pucks to eliminate second hand chances. He focuses on covering the lower portion of the net. He will come out of the net to play pucks.

Joey Cormier - '01 Goaltender - Toledo Cherokee (USPHL Premier)

10/24/2021 - USPHL Premier Detroit Showcase

Cormier was able to find some good results over the past weekend in Detroit and really uses his athleticism to his advantage. Joey is a smaller goalie in size but uses his quick feet and edges to build his success. His quickness is impressive and something to be noticed as he builds on his good start.

Very technical composed goaltender with head, shoulders and hands always in control, and constantly trying to stay square to puck. Beat high glove and a weird bounce on goal #1. Was very impressive in shootout staying big and patient. Has the mechanics and intelligence to be a strong division III goaltender for SUNY Potsdam, will need to add explosion and power to shuffles and slides.

Johnny Derrick - '01 Goaltender - West Kelowna Warriors (BCHL)

10/22/2021 - Victoria vs West Kelowna

Multiple breakaway saves. Came up big during 6 on 4 powerplay with net empty late in game. 14 saves in third

10/23/2021 - West Kelowna vs Alberni Valley

6'2" pro style butterfly goaltender. Excellent reads coming off goal line, made multiple big desperation saves. 4 goals against, 1) PP goal from below circles beat clean glove side 2) Net front scramble 3) Breakaway 4) 1-Timer from in between circles.

Josh Seeley - '01 Goaltender - Danbury Jr Hat Tricks (NAHL)

11/06/2021 - Danbury Jr Hat Tricks vs New Jersey Titans

Goal #1 - Defensive misque during breakout leads to low to high cycle into a point shot. Shot is partially blocked with rebound popping into air, batted home by #2 Stephen Willey (NJT) Goal #2 - Powerplay goal, blocked shot turns into quick opportunity in front. Goal #3 Another point shot, hits Titan forward and lands on stick for easy put away at side of net. Quick reactions but desperation. Goal #4 goal line crash with limited D backpressure, beaten to middle of ice, blocker side. Goal #5 5 mins left, blocker side shot from around faceoff dot gets lost in gear, Titan player finds behind him for open net tap in.

Justin Grenon - '02 Goaltender - Jersey Shore Whalers (USPHL Premier)

09/18/2021 - Jersey Whalers vs WBS Knights

#1 Smooth, traditional butterfly goaltender comfortable in his reverse and butterfly stances. Strong reads in net crash plays, playing percentages by sliding into shots, playing big. Goals against were fine, beat high blocker

Kannon Flageolle - '02 Goaltender - Hampton Roads Whalers (USPHL Premier)

09/27/2021 - USPHL Premier Raleigh Southeast Showcase

Kannon has gotten his junior career off to a very good start and he was able to play well over this past weekend during the showcase platform. He's a well-structured and balanced goaltender who can move well and compete.

Kannon Flageolle - '02 Goaltender - Hampton Roads Whalers (USPHL Premier)

10/03/2021 - Charlotte Rush vs Hampton Roads Whalers

Coverage style right handed goaltender who has smart reading ability and first shot save control. Struggled with upper body and stick control in scramble moments. Beat on one timer and double fake shot, wrap around goal, also struggled low blocker.

Kristoffer Eberly - '02 Goaltender - Northern Cyclones (USPHL NCDC)

11/12/2021 - Boston Advantage vs Northern Cyclones

40 Shots 36 saves in loss. Very controlled movements in crease, led by level head, shoulders and hands, rarely not square to the puck. Very calm feet, and limited movement when coming out of butterfly saves. Beaten on rebounds, and powerplay one timer but in good positioning for both.

12/11/2021 - Northern Cyclones vs Boston Advantage

40 Shots 38 saves , wide coverage goaltender who plays with controlled movements and limited oversliding. Made multiple breakaway / high wuality chance saves in 3rd period. Also dealt with traffic well, with a wide low coverage in his stance.

12/17/2021 - Northern Cyclones vs NH Jr Monarchs

32 shots 31 saves, flukey only goal from blocker save just doesn't get all of it. Plays controlled in his crease, with solid coverage and is constantly trying to be square to puck.

Lenny Perno - '02 Goaltender - Elmira Jr Enforcers (USPHL Premier)

11/07/2021 - Elmira Jr Enforcers vs Wilkes Barre Scranton Knights

#20 Butterfly goaltender who loves to play in controlled sliding motions, using his height to cover space. Some situations of over sliding, but made athletic recovery saves in desperation. 4th goal 5 minutes into third seemed to be guessing on shot, was in good positioning and crease depth. Smart in reads, gets out of crease quickly in butterfly to cut down on angles, active hands to make saves outside chest area. Fight in third after slight scrum after whistle while covering puck, gloves off swinging at Knight forward, ejected.

Logan Palmer - '01 Goaltender - Utica Jr Comets (USPHL Premier)

10/31/2021 - Utica Jr Comets vs Northern Cyclones

Technical goaltender with correct skating technique and positioning tactics. Just needs to add power / strength, sometimes slow getting up in recoveries. 1 goal against on 3 on 1. Shootout win but beaten twice low glove.

Marco Duronio - '01 Goaltender - Ogden Mustangs (USPHL Premier)

11/20/2021 - Ogden Mustangs vs Charlotte Rush

18 shots 15 saves, plays with a low chest level when in butterfly. Beaten off of rebounds and back door goals, showed a want to handle the puck, as well as strong crease awareness and average athleticism

12/18/2021 - Lawrenceville School Winter Tournament

Very smooth, explosive in movements, everything leads / starts with his head. Limited waisted motion. Was beaten on rebounds or breakdowns in front. Reads and reactionary saves were very good. Active stick, textbook movements from stance to butterfly, not much head/shoulders drop when in butterfly. Wants to be ahead of puck, all starts with his head / tracking.

Nathan Mueller - '01 Goaltender - Boston Jr Rangers (EHL)

10/23/2021 - EHL All Star College Series

Athletic mobile keeper with quick movements. He fights through screens to create seeing lane for himself. He has a quick recovery to bounce back up to face second hand chances. He keeps arms tight into body and limits the amount of shooting holes. He has long effective T-pushes to cut down on shooting angles.

Noah Grannan - '02 Goaltender - Sioux Falls Stampede (USHL)

10/29/2021 - Sioux Falls Stampede vs Des Moines Buccaneers

24 shots 22 saves in first USHL start. Wide base, and active hands with average athleticism. Was beat twice high blocker. Needs improvement reading plays and checking slot when puck is below goal line

Nolan Suggs - '02 Goaltender - Jamestown (NAHL)

09/18/2021 - NAHL Blaine Showcase

Fundamentally sound butterfly goalie who consistently eliminates the bottom of the net. He moves well from post to post. He uses his pads well to deflect shots into the corners and away from the high danger areas. He will leave his crease to play the puck.

Peyton Grainer - '02 Goaltender - Jersey Hitmen (USPHL NCDC)

10/23/2021 - Jersey Hitmen vs Connecticut Jr Rangers

He is fundamentally solid. He is very quick and agile in the net. He recovers very well putting himself in position to square up to any second chance opportunities. He rapidly smothers up any potential rebounds or uses his stick to knock pucks into the corners and away from high danger areas. He frequently communicates to teammates, directing traffic and signaling where opponents' pressure would be coming from.

Remington Keopple - '02 Goaltender - Des Moines Buccaneers (USHL)

10/29/2021 - Sioux Falls Stampede vs Des Moines Buccaneers

22 shots 19 saves. Close hands and feet, with not the largest coverage zone but is constantly in position due to smart instincts and smart feet while shuffling. Relies on positioning and athleticism to make saves, scramble / uncontrolled hands during rebound or recovery situations. Strong on penalty kill 5 on 4 and 5 on 3, constantly getting to shot lanes before passes, and battles for pucks through traffic. Beat on wrap around overcommitting on rush, rebound goal and beat five hole on breakaway for OT game winner.

Ronan Mobley - '01 Goaltender - New Hampshire Avalanche (EHL)

12/15/2021 - New Hampshire Avalanche vs Team Maryland

27 shots 25 saves for the division III prospect. Strong patience / IQ in scrambles in front, and explodes off goal line to take down angles quickly. Very aggressive crease positioning, very big chest on first shot opportunities. Showed patience and the ability to cover great distance when sliding during shootout.

Ronan Mobley - '01 Goaltender - New Hampshire Avalanche (EHL)

12/16/2021 - New Hampshire Avalanche vs Vermont Lumberjacks

20 shots 19 Saves. Great puck handler, righty. Consistent reader of game, can be very explosive and acrobatic in desperation saves, but could reduce the need with simpler movements and less over sliding. Controlled right hander with a tight seal and a low wide athletic stance tracking close plays. Smooth in post RVH coverage with an active stick to block passes through the crease. Leads with the head. Multiple breakaway saves. Nothing he could do on back door goal against, bought shot on mini 2 on 1, stuck in sand

12/18/2021 - Seacoast Spartans vs New Hampshire Avalanche

#33 26 shots 24 saves, low wide stance with active hands. Plays a very controlled style of game, especially in butterfly and post coverage situations. Plays deep in crease at times, relying on quick hands to get to pucks. Very comfortable at aggressive depths out of crease, doesn't get lost.

Sam Evola - '01 Goaltender - Johnstown (NAHL)

09/18/2021 - NAHL Blaine Showcase

He moves extremely well laterally and covers the bottom of the net. He is strong on his angles always looking to challenge the shooters. He has a quick recovery, which allows him to get into position to stop second chance opportunities. He limits rebounds against, quickly smothering the puck.

Sebastian Woods - '01 Goaltender - Utica Jr Comets (USPHL NCDC)

10/23/2021 - PAL Jr Islanders vs Utica Comets

Slightly undersized, aggressive butterfly goaltender, scambly at times due to positioning causing need to cover larger distances in recoveries. 34 shots 31 saves 3-2 loss. Made some impressive saves and competes.

11/06/2021 - Rockets Hockey Club vs Utica Jr Comets

Athletic, quick goaltender with a low wide stance with compact hands. Prefers sliding & butterfly approach to movements but needs to keep upper body controlled to avoid oversliding or over rotating. Not the tallest goaltender and relies on quick hands for high shots. 28 shots 25 saves

Shane Soderwall - '02 Goaltender - Anchorage (NAHL)

09/18/2021 - NAHL Blaine Showcase

Large keeper who is fundamentally sound, always looking to cover the lower portion of the net in his butterfly style. He plays his angles well, minimizing the net that opponents see. He handles the puck decently well and makes simple decisions to kick-start the breakout. He could improve his lateral movement on second hand chances.

Ty Franchi - '01 Goaltender - Seacoast Spartans (EHL)

09/18/2021 - Seacoast Spartans vs New Hampshire Avalanche

#1 First save goaltender, struggled playing the puck. Big puckhandling error end of first results in goal. Aggressive in crease,
